

**CARBON COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFFS
MERIT COMMISSION
NOTICE OF EXAMINATION**

The Carbon County Deputy Sheriffs Merit Commission (Commission) will be compiling a roster from which qualified individuals will be selected when openings for Carbon County Deputy Sheriffs occur. Utah law requires the Commission to administer competitive examinations to determine the qualification of applicants for positions as deputy sheriffs. Applicants who qualify to take the examinations must score at least 70% on the written aptitude test and pass a physical fitness test at pre-P.O.S.T. standards. Both examinations will be conducted by the Carbon County Merit Commission.

Applicants for the examination process must be a minimum of 21 years of years of age and citizens of the United States. Applicants will be disqualified if they have been convicted of a criminal offense inimical to the public service, or involving moral turpitude. Applicants who successfully complete the examination process will then be further interviewed personally by the Commission. The deadline for submitting applications with a resume, applicant questionnaire and a UCJIS "Right of Access" background check is March 12, 2015 at 4:00 p.m.
