BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION



Beginning at a point which lies S.24°58'22"W., 700.62 feet from the northwest corner of said Section 24; said point being the most northwesterly corner of the following described parcel; thence N.75°13'15"E., 225.00 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve being concave southeasterly and having a radius of 1180.00 feet; thence easterly along said curve through a central angle of 22'47'19" and an arc distance of 469.33 feet; thence tangent from last said curve, S.81°59'26"E., 253.26 feet to an angle point; thence S.79°09'17"E., 121.72 feet to an angle point; thence S.71°03'14"E., 370.57 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve being concave northeasterly and having a radius of 620.00 feet; thence easterly along said curve through a central angle of 22 31 59" and an arc distance of 243.83 feet; thence tangent from last said curve N.86°24'47"E., 198.47 feet; thence S.05°05'52"E., 410.00 feet; thence N.84°54'08"E., 100.79 feet; thence S.05 09'58"E., 172.62 feet; thence West 1695.77 feet; thence N.00 07'15"W., 214.87 feet to a point on the northerly right - of - way line of the Denver and Rio Grande Railbed, 100.00 feet in width as recorded in Book 5-F of Deeds, at page 339 dated July 3, 1913, of official records of said county; thence westerly along last said northerly right-of-way line, N.88 12 43 W., 140.51 feet; thence N.01° 47 17 E., 10.00 feet to a point on a non-tangent curve being concave southeasterly and having a radius of 450.00 feet, a radial line of said curve at said point bears N.35°04'55"W; thence non-radial from last curve, N.30°41'46"W 143.75 feet; thence N.24°16'40"W., 50.00 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve being concave to the northwest and having a radius of 20.00 feet; thence northerly along said curve through a central angle of 86'56'50" and an arc distance of 30.35 feet to the beginning of a reverse curve being concave to the northeast and having a radius of 859.12 feet, a radial line of said reverse curve at said point bears S.68 46'30"W., thence northwesterly along said reverse curve through a central angle of 06 26'45" and an arc distance of 96.65 feet; thence tangent from last said reverse curve, N.14°46'45"W., 174.89 feet to the point of beginning.
