AN ORDINANCE, NO. 60.

Annexing to, and extending the limits of Price City, Utah.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Price, Utah:

Sec. 1. That the real property hereinafter described, lying contiguous to the corporate limits of Price City, Utah, shall be annexed to the said Price City, and the limits of said Price City shall be extended to embrace the real property hereinafter described.

The real property annexed to Price City and the limits of Price City embraced in this ordinance, is described as follows; to-wit:

Beginning at the West 1/4 corner of Section 16, Township 14 South Range 10 East, Salt Lake Meridian; running thence South 1/4 mile; thence East 1 mile more or less to the South-east corner of the North-east quarter of the South-east quarter of said Section 16; thence North 1/2 mile; thence West 1905 ft.; thence North 671 ft.; thence West 2061.1 ft.; thence South 1991 ft.; thence 1/4 mile to the place of beginning, embracing the North half of the South-west quarter, the North half of the South-east quarter, the South-east quarter of the North-east quarter the South-half of the South-west quarter of the North-east quarter and the South-east quarter of the North-west quarter, of said Section 16, also blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 of Parkdale Townsite, together with the streets and alleys adjacent to the said blocks.

Section 2. This ordinance, shall take effect and be in force on and after the 18th day of December, A. D. 1920.

This ordinance, after adoption, and approval by the Mayor, shall be deposited in the office of the City Recorder and published once in the Sun a weekly newspaper, or general circulation, published within the City of Price.
