SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Carl Nyman, County Surveyor of Carbon County, Utah, do hereby certify that on July 25, 1928, by authority of the owners, I surveyed, subdivided and platted into lots and streets the following described tract of land:
Beginning at the South west corner of Lot 3, Section 18, Township 18
South, Range 10 East, Salt Lake Meridian; thence N. 89° 43' E., 346.8 feet;
thence S. 0° 37' W., 176.48 feet; thence N. 89° 43' E., 612.4 feet; thence N. 0° 37' E.,
119.16 feet; thence N. 7° 02' E., 125.0 feet; thence Northwesterly along the D. & R. R.
G.W. railroad right of way to a point N. 0° 26' E. of the point of beginning; thence
S. 0° 26' W., 414.5 feet to the point of beginning.

Also, that this map is a full, true and correct map of the tract of land
above described with the dimensions and field notes correctly shown
thereon; that the azimuth has been correctly determined by solar and
polaris observations; that the survey monuments have been correctly
placed as shown hereon and that the plat comprises what is to
