The boundary of the Land embraced in the proposed extension is represented by the heavy line hereon and the Land is particularly described as follows to wit: Beginning at the West 1/4 Corner of Section 16, T. 7 N. R. 10 E. S. 1/4 M., running thence South 1/4 Mile, thence East 1/4 Mile more or less to the S.E. Corner of the NE 1/4 Sec. 16, thence North 1/2 Mile West 1905 ft., thence North 671 ft., thence West 201 1/4 ft., thence South 1991 ft., thence West 1/4 Mile to the place of beginning, embracing the NE 1/4, NW 1/4, SE 1/4, SW 1/4, SW 1/4, and the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of said Section 16, also Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of PARK DALE TOWNSITE, together with the Streets and Alleys adjacent to said Blocks.

AN ORDINANCE, 1920.

Annexing to, and extending the limits of Price City, Utah.

Enacted by the City Council of Price, Utah.

Section 1. That the real property hereinafter described, lying southward to the corporate limits of Price City, Utah, shall be annexed to the said Price City, and the limits of said Price City shall be extended to embrace the real property hereinafter specified.

The real property embraced in Price City and the limits of Price City embraced in this ordinance, is described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at the west 1/4 corner of section 16, Township 7 N. Range 10 E. S. 1/4 M., shall take a course; running thence South 1/4 Mile thence West 1/4 Mile less or more to the south-east corner of the north-east quarter of the north-east quarter of said section 16; thence north-east corner of the north-east quarter of the north-east quarter of said section 16; thence South 1991 ft.; thence 1/4 mile to the place of beginning.

This ordinance, after adoption, and approval by the Mayor, shall be deposited in the office of the City Recorder and published once in the Sun a weekly newspaper, of general circulation, published within the City of Price.
