

BUILDING INSPECTOR

Carbon County has an immediate opening for a Building Inspector responsible for inspecting commercial and residential structures to insure compliance with Building Codes adopted by the State of Utah and the various jurisdictions he/she serves. Will be responsible for conducting regular review of codes, ordinances and regulations. Helps to adapt, modify, or rewrite codes as needed. Directed to enforce the provisions of the building codes as well as render interpretations of the code and to adopt policies and procedures in order to clarify the application of its provisions. Will conduct on-site inspections of plumbing, electrical, mechanical, and structural properties of various buildings in the County and the Cities contracting with Carbon County for inspections.

Requires a minimum of two (2) years of post-secondary education or equivalent experience and at least four (4) years of active employment in the building trades. Must be a licensed or able to become a licensed Utah Combination Inspector. Must be able to readily read and understand complicated legalistic building codes and navigate computers, software, and other technology to accelerate and improve the building inspection process.

Salary range will be \$40,000/year to \$46,000/year depending on prior experience and qualifications.

Carbon County currently offers a generous benefit package including but not limited to: Health Insurance, Life Insurance, and URS Retirement plans.

Will be required to pass a background check, physical, and drug screen.
