On-call hours are Monday thru Friday, 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 a.m. Saturday and Sundays 12-24 hour on-call shifts. Schedule will be rotated with co-workers. Must work within guidelines by the State of Utah and Center Director. Must be 18 years of age or older. Must pass drug screening, physical, and BCI background check. Must be certified in CPR and First Aid and able to obtain a food handler’s permit. Two years prior experience in child care setting preferred.
