Uniformed and Overseas Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA)

Military/Overseas voters will be mailed or emailed a ballot 45 days prior to the Election date. Ballots must be postmarked or returned no later than 8 p.m. on election day. Your ballot will come to you through a new program called Enhanced Voting Systems, please watch for it.
