HERE FOR A FULL DAY?

Nine Mile Canyon

Visit the petroglyphs in Nine Mile Canyon. It is a two-hour drive through the 46-mile canyon, but you should plan on a full day of exploring to fully appreciate the canyon. It is a beautiful drive, so make sure to bring snacks and drinks on your trek! When visiting the canyon, we ask one simple thing: leave it just as you found it. #LoveltAndLeavelt

From Price, travel approximately 9 miles South East to Wellington, Turn Left at Millers Truck Stop onto Soldier Creek Rd.

Hike to Gordon Creek

Take an hour-long, two-mile out and back hike to **Gordon Creek Waterfall**. Featuring two waterfalls and a historic cabin, Gordon Creek Trail is a hidden oasis open to many types of explorers: hikers, trail runners, equestrians, mountain bikers, and ATV riders.

From Price, head North for 10 miles turning left on Consumers Road to the trailhead.

Experience Historic Helper

Plan at least half a day on **Helper's historic Main Street** visiting art galleries, antique shops, and boutiques. Enjoy a relaxing lunch before spending an hour stroll along the river on the **Helper Walkway**. Visit the **Helper Museum** to learn about the history that has shaped Carbon County

Drive the Energy Loop Scenic Byway

This **85-mile loop** offers breathtaking views of Southeastern Utah. The drive goes through historic mining towns, by coal-fired power plants and to lookout points within the **Manti-La Sal National Forest**.
