

PRIMARY ELECTION INFORMATION

June 30, 2020

For this election Carbon County will only have a Republican Contest. If you are NOT affiliated with the Republican Party you will NOT Automatically receive a ballot in the mail.

HOW CAN I VOTE ON THE REPUBLICAN BALLOT?

The Republican Party REQUIRES you to affiliate with the Republican Party by June 19, 2020 to participate in this Primary election.

Mail in Ballot: Affix postage and return by U.S. Mail

*Important Covid 19 changes to the June 30, 2020 Primary Election

- There will be no in person early voting
- There will be no regular polling places on Election Day except for voters requiring ADA assistance
- There will be no in person voter registration. Please register to vote online or by mail
- There will be no provisional ballots or election day registration
- The voter registration deadline is June 19th (11 days before election day)
