HOW TO PLAY

- Go to www.geocaching.com to sign up for a free account.
- Download the Geocaching® app for your smartphone or GPS enabled device.
- Search by GeoTours and enter code **GT4D7**.
- Find an SPX GeoTour geocache and record the code word found in the cache container in the appropriate box on the passport.
- Some caches contain tradable objects! If you remove something from the cache, replace it with something of equal value.
- Place the cache back where you found it.
- Record your find on the Geocaching® app!
- After locating 30 or more caches, redeem your SPX GeoTour trackable geotag by completing the form on the back.
